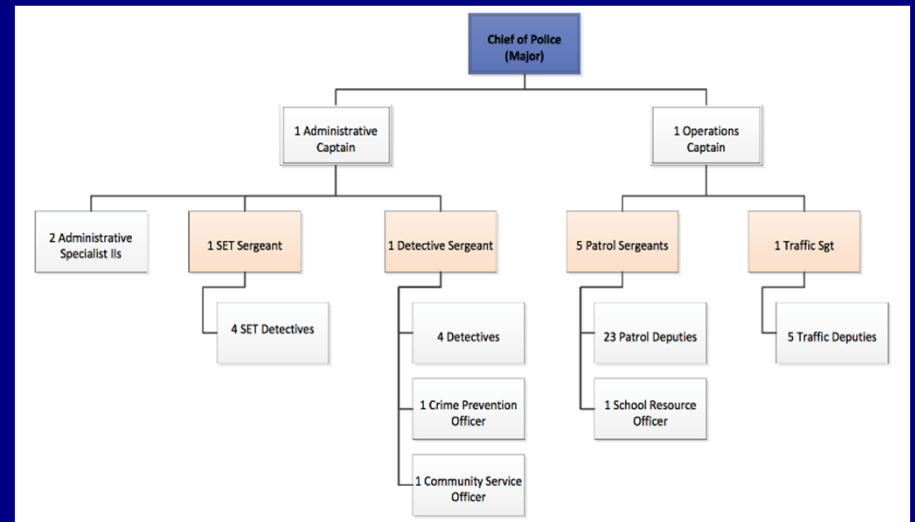

Shoreline Police Staffing

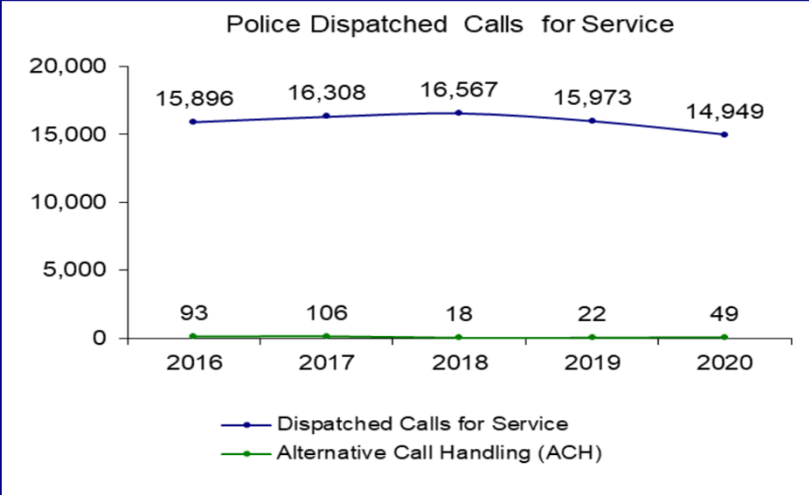
54 FTE's assigned to Shoreline

- 7 vacancies

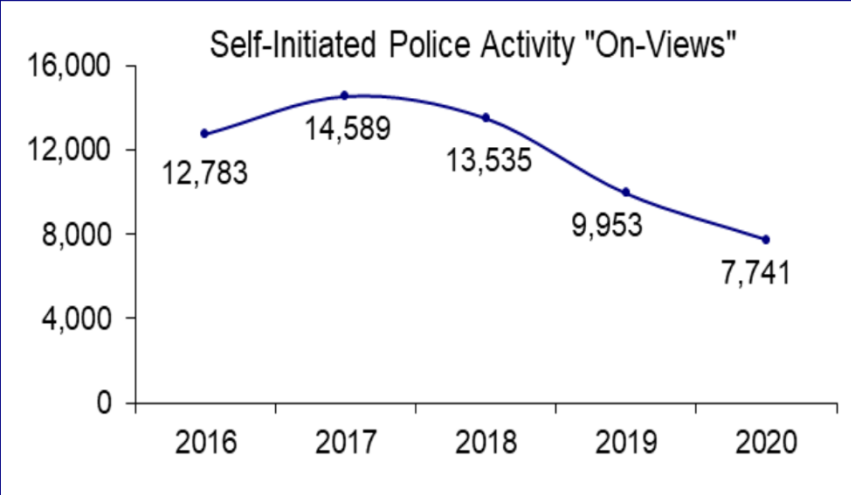

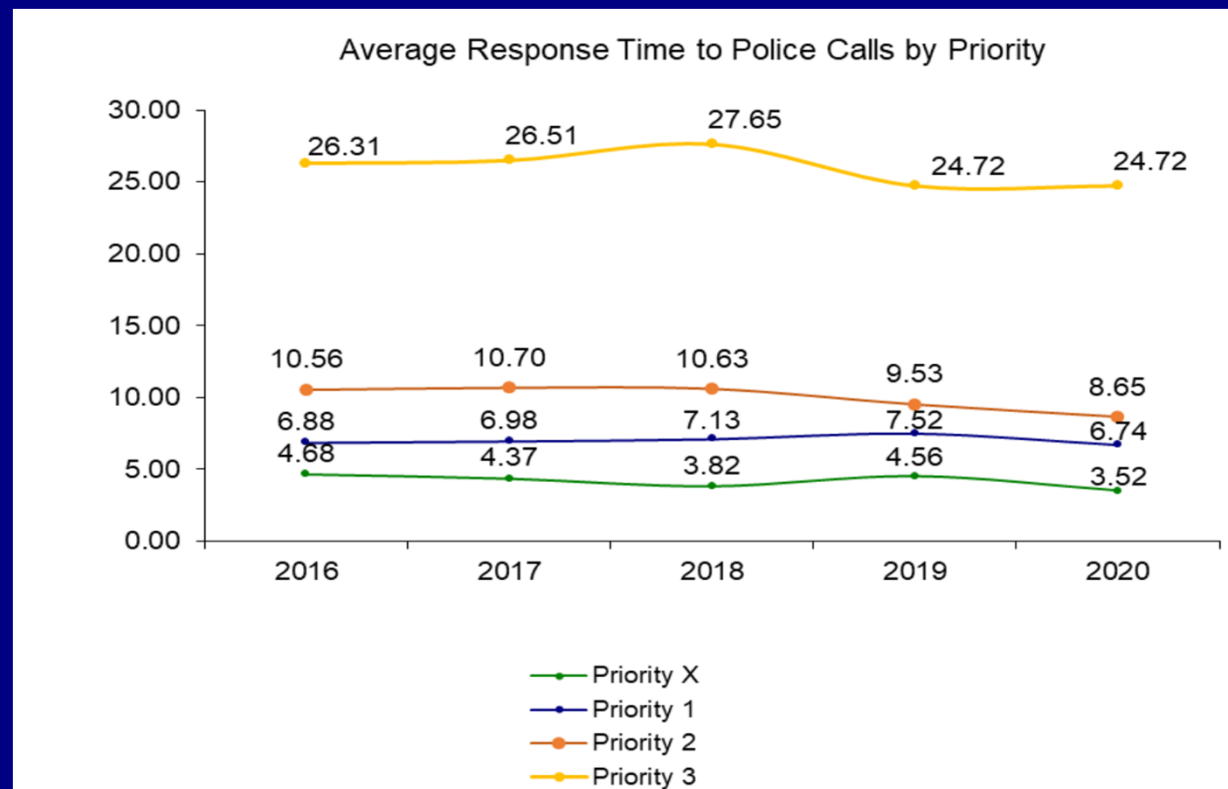
Dispatched Calls for Service



Self Initiated Activity

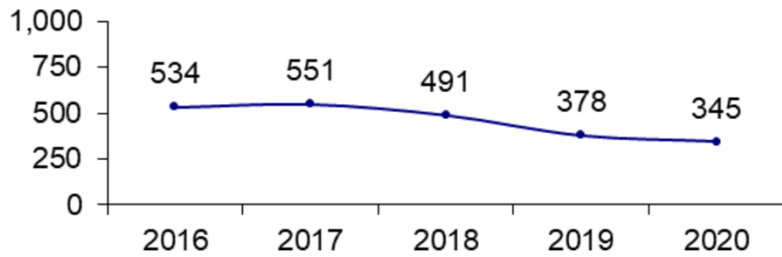


Response Times

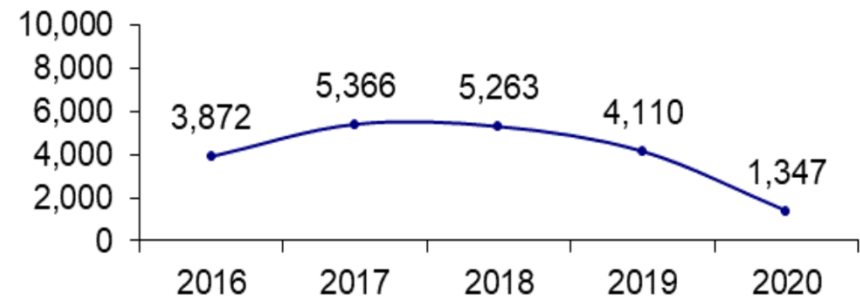

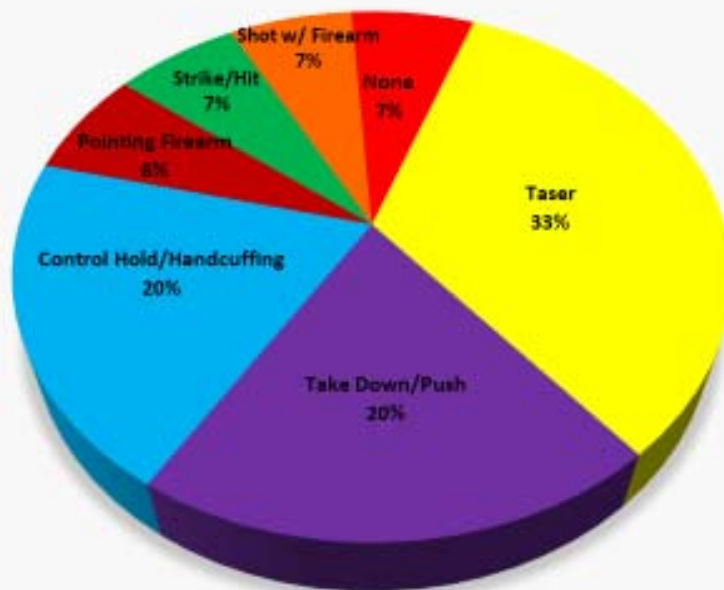

2021 Legislative Changes

- **HB 1310** – Physical force can only be used if there's probable cause to make an arrest and/or to protect against an imminent threat of serious injury
- **HB 5476** – Blake decision, controlled substance possession or use, requires two assessment referrals before an arrest can be made
- **HB 1054** – Tactics, most KCSO policies complies, restrictive pursuit policies
- **HB 1140** – Juvenile access to an attorney
- **SB 5259** – Authorizes AG to require additional data elements in the use of force program
