



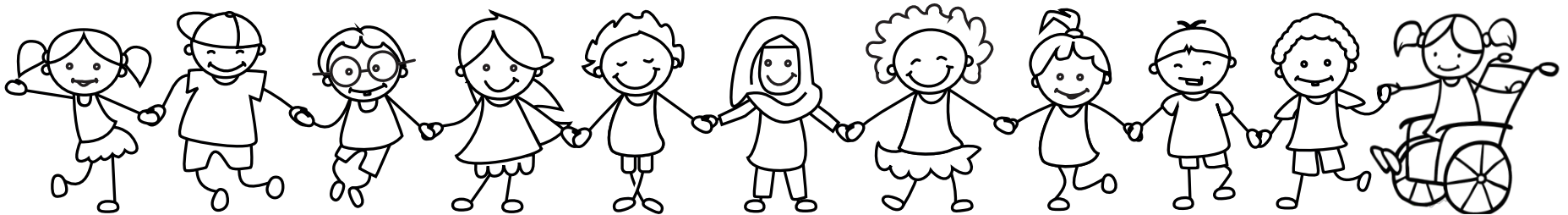

*It is important to the City of Shoreline that all community members feel valued and a sense of belonging.*

*In January 2017, Shoreline City Council passed Resolution No. 401, declaring the City of Shoreline to be an inviting, equitable, and safe community for all and prohibited inquiries by City employees regarding immigration status.*

*In November 2020, the Shoreline City Council adopted Resolution No. 467 Declaring the City's Commitment to Building an Anti-Racist Community. The Resolution states the City will address and undo all the ways racism is maintained in individual, institutional, and structural levels by changing policies, behaviors, and beliefs.*

*This work is hard and ongoing but core to the vision of Shoreline as a thriving, friendly city where people of all ages, cultures, and economic backgrounds love to live, work, and play, and most of all call home.*
