1. PURPOSE/SCOPE:

The purpose of Temporary Emergency Policy No. 7 is to provide guidance and establish procedures regarding the use of paid leave and pay for City employees under the COVID-19 Health Emergency declaration. Temporary Emergency Order No. 7, issued January 4, 2021, established the following policies:

COVID-19 Donated Leave Pool Policy **City Closure Pay Policy Emergency Paid Sick Leave Act Policy Expanded Family and Medical Leave Policy**

2. AMENDMENT

1. Expiration date:

Temporary Emergency Order No. 7, as amended by Temporary Emergency Oder No. 7.1, shall be amended to expire at 11:59 pm Local Time on November 1, 2021.

2. Application of Amendments to Sections

Section 5(C) Emergency Paid Sick Leave Act (EPSL) Policy is amended as follows:

C. Emergency Paid Sick Leave Act (EPSL) Policy (Effective 4/1/2020 – 3/31/2021 8/31/2021 11/1/2021)

9. Duration of Benefits, Carryout, and Payout

Emergency Paid Sick Leave will be available until 11:59 pm Local Time, March 31, 2021 August 31, 2021 November 1, 2021. Any unused portion of this leave entitlement shall not carry over to the next year or be paid out to employees.

Section 5(D)(8) Expanded Paid Family and Medical Leave (EPFML) Policy – Duration of Benefits is amended to read as follows:

8. Duration of Benefits

EFMLA leave will be available until 11:59 pm Local Time, March 31, 2021 August 31, 2021 November 1, 2021.

3. NO OTHER AMENDMENTS:

This Amendment extends the expiration date. All other policies, definitions, and procedures set forth in Temporary Emergency Order No. 7, issued January 4, 2021, and as amended by Temporary Emergency Order No. 7.1, remain in full force and effect.
