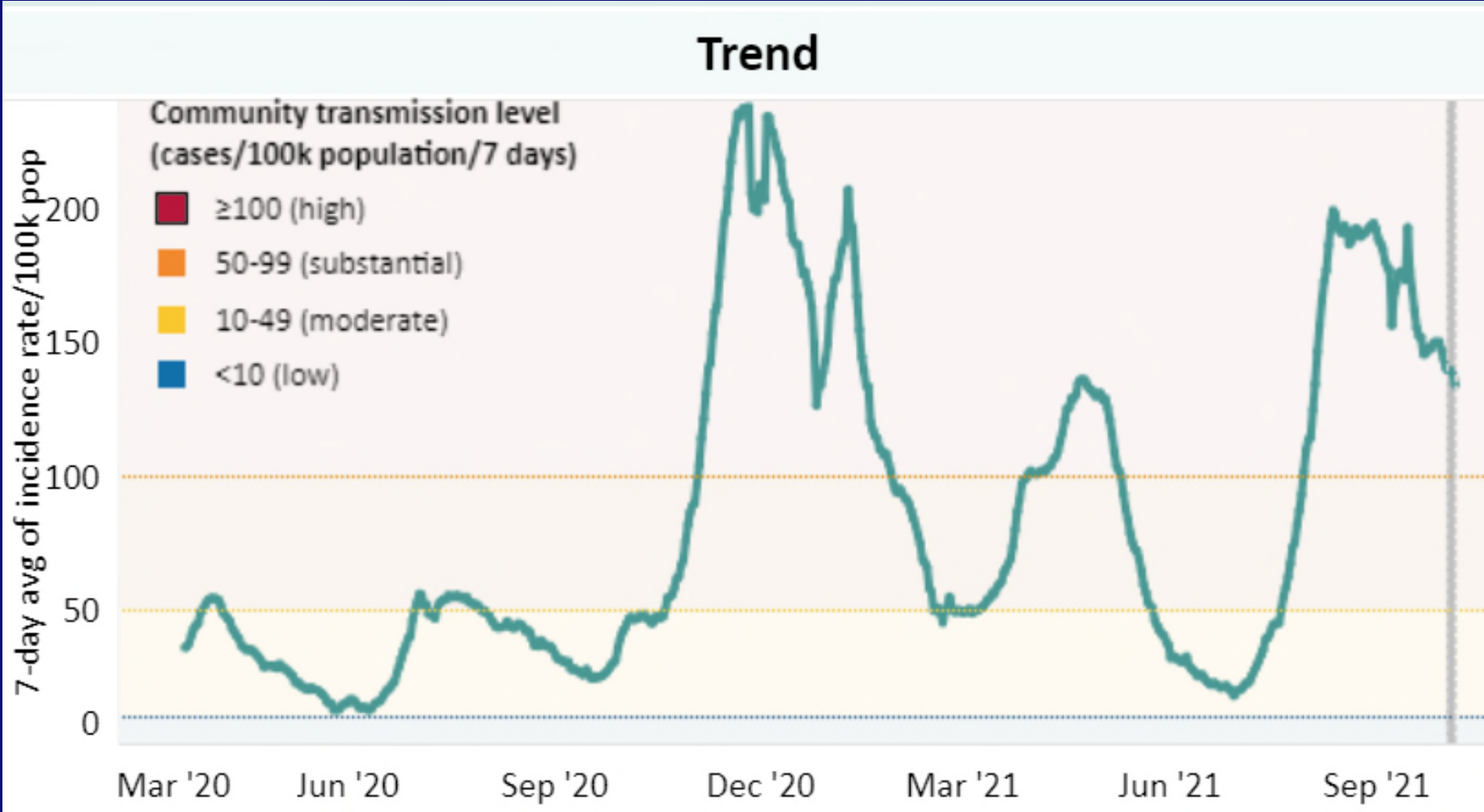

# Public Health Order: Proof of vaccination or negative test

- New Public Health order goes into effect on October 25 for all of King County.
- Proof of COVID-19 vaccination or proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken in the last 72 hours will be required for:
  - Indoor dining, bars, and recreational activities of any size including theaters, gyms, performances, etc.
  - Outdoor events with 500 or more people.
