



PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Shoreline's urban forest is an irreplaceable asset that is part of the greater ecosystem of the Puget Sound region; and

WHEREAS, the Green Shoreline Partnership, a collaborative effort between the City of Shoreline and Forterra, actively engages residents in the restoration of forested parkland; and

WHEREAS, since the start of the Green Shoreline Partnership, hundreds of volunteers have dedicated countless hours to improving the health of local forests by planting native trees and shrubs and groundcovers in Shoreline's parks; and

WHEREAS, the City of Shoreline wishes to encourage residents' involvement in the protection of the City's urban forest by participating in a planting event held each fall in Shoreline's parks;

WHEREAS, the efforts of volunteers as coordinated by the City of Shoreline through partnership with Forterra harmonize perfectly with the values of Arbor Day, hereto celebrated on this day;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Will Hall, Mayor of the City of Shoreline, on behalf of the Shoreline City Council, do hereby proclaim November 16, 2019 as

and encourage the community to participate in Green Shoreline events throughout the year.
