

Protect Your Home and Property: Prepare for Heavy Rainstorms

Fall and winter rainstorms are getting stronger due to climate change.

This means there is a greater risk of flooding for low-lying neighborhoods and properties located below the street. Prepare for heavy rainstorms and help reduce flooding in your neighborhood.

Report Active Flooding Immediately City of Shoreline: (206) 801-2700

Call 911 first for any flooding that is a major risk to safety

City response is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week

During severe storms, the City must prioritize its response to the most impacted areas and may not be able to respond to all calls immediately. City crews will respond as soon as they are available.

Prepare Your Property Before the Rain Comes

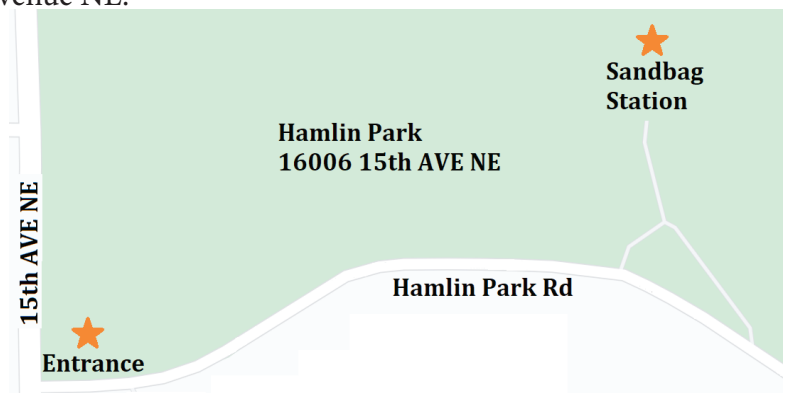
- Clean out roof gutters, downspouts, and all other rainwater drainage structures that you have. Remove all leaves and debris so that rainwater can flow away from your home. Redirect downspouts and other drainage flows to keep water away from your home.
- Use sandbags to protect your home when water is flowing towards it. There is a free you-fill sandbag station at Hamlin Park (16006 15th Avenue NE). Bring your own shovel to fill up sandbags. The sandbag station is located in the first parking lot on the left as you enter from 15th Avenue NE.
- Test your sump pump before large storms. Consider installing a backup battery in case the power goes out.

Protect Your Family and Pets

- Plan to elevate your furnace, water heater, washer/dryer, and electrical panel if they are in an area that may flood.
- Store valuables and household chemicals up high, away from the ground.

Help Prevent Neighborhood Flooding

- Clear leaves, debris, and snow from storm drains and ditches near your home to keep the pipes that carry rainwater from backing up. Join the City of Shoreline's Adopt-A-Drain program to support a city-wide effort to keep storm drains and ditches free of debris. www.shorelinewa.gov/adopt-a-drain
- Keep roadside ditches empty. Never put soil, debris or fill of any kind into the ditch near your home. Ditches are critical to moving water away from homes and neighborhoods and returning it back to natural waterways.
- Do not rake, sweep, or blow leaves, pine needles, grass, or any debris onto the sidewalk or streets. This can clog the pipes that carry rainwater and cause flooding. Throw out yard waste in your green bin.
- If you see a storm drain or ditch back up during a storm that you cannot clean, report it immediately to the City of Shoreline (206) 801-2700.
