- 1. See first attachment it would be centerline curb extending past the northernmost Safeway driveway on 15<sup>th</sup> Ave NE south of 175<sup>th</sup>.
- 2. This is the same concept, and yes there was some negative feedback. I have also heard support for the idea, particularly from some members of the North City Neighborhood Association.
- 3. Correct, 145<sup>th</sup> is fully outside of the City of Shoreline jurisdiction. Additionally, the limited access area on 5<sup>th</sup> Ave NE at I-5 (as well as ramps and underpass at I-5) are WSDOT limited access, which means the State is primarily responsible for those areas.

Just a couple of questions about the traffic study. In the City Street Intersection Strategies....

- 175th & 15th I'm having a hard time visualizing the "northernmost driveway on the south leg" curb thing that is described, is there a drawing or something I could reference?
- 175th & 10th there's a reference to lowering to 3 lanes or considering adding a future roundabout... I think the lane reduction idea came up before I was on council and the neighborhood responded in a big way (negatively). Is this the same suggestion? something different?
- Finally 145th is not included in the report, is that because it's technically Seattle?. Just double checking. 145th and the southbound entrance to I-5 is where I regularly see evidence of collisions.
