# GEOTECHNICAL ACTIVITY COMING SOON 10<sup>TH</sup> AVE NE STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS

## **GEOTECHNICAL SURVEY WORK IS COMING TO YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD!**

As part of the City of Shoreline's 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE Stormwater Improvement project, the City has hired a consultant to explore groundwater levels to inform the design of a future stormwater improvement project. The geotechnical engineer will dig a pit and test stormwater infiltration rates by the road in front of your home.

### WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Work trucks and machinery on the road and shoulder in front of your home during daylight hours.
- A hole will be dug and re-filled during the process, with any grass being restored.

We recommend that you park your car in your driveway, and off of the road shoulder to assist us in accessing the area of testing.

#### SCHEDULE:

We anticipate that this work will occur the week of January 18<sup>th</sup> to January 21<sup>st</sup>, and last less than a day.
