

The Oaks Enhanced Shelter Update

- Shelter continues to operate at capacity.
- 38 Shoreline residents were served between July and December 2021.
- 911 calls:
 - On average, 2.11 calls per month
 - When operating as a nursing home, location averaged 4.29 calls per month (Data from 2018 and 2019)
- Success story: The shelter helped an expectant couple to transition from an organized homeless camp to permanent housing before the birth of their child.

RADAR grant from DOJ

- The US Department of Justice's Bureau of Justice Assistance has awarded the City, in partnership with the Center for Human Services and the North Sound RADAR program a \$500,000 grant over three project years
- Grant will fund a "Treatment Navigator" role at Center for Human Servoces.
- RADAR staff will accompany people in behavioral health crisis directly to an initial appointment with the Treatment Navigator to help them engage in services and connect them with long-term supports.
