- 1. Please remove the construction contract for Rodarte Construction from the <u>consent calendar on</u> Feb 28, 2022
- 2. 17 tall mature trees will be removed (see attached list). The count of "17" is for trees in good and fair condition.
- 3. Please review & revise the design of the sidewalk so the trees can be retained.
- 4. Construct a trail/bike lane on the west side and keep the 5' wide bike lane and 6' wide sidewalk on the east side
- 5. Elevate the sidewalk to save the tree roots and eliminate the need to cut down the trees
- 6. Wrap the sidewalk around the trees
- 7. Please review the design and provide opportunity for public comment.
