Hi Chris -

Yes we have been at 100% design of 5th Avenue NE, as was shared in the staff report on February 7, 2022. We were out to bid at that time and as you know the award of the construction contract is on tonight's consent agenda.

As you saw in tonight's staff report, the contract for the project requires that clearing limits be marked by the contractor, and staff will do an additional review of tree impacts within those limits and evaluate areas where clearing may be reduced to preserve trees/improve tree outcomes, and approve tree removals with the contractor. This is one more opportunity to see if any additional trees can be retained. If there are any design changes from this review those changes will be made via change order.
