Dear Shoreline City Council:

I urge each of you to use your authority to save and protect trees in Shoreline by voting to:

1. APPROVE the definition of a 6" diameter/dbh significant tree.
2. REQUIRE PERMITTING (in all tree codes) for the removal of any tree over 24" dbh.
3. DENY Director authority to waive and reduce retention of trees on construction sites.
4. DENY Director authority to reduce replacement trees on construction sites.
5. RAISE SIDEWALKS above tree roots for the 17 trees in good and fair condition in the 5th Ave NE Sidewalk Design proposal.
6. ENSURE PROTECTION of the 100' tall, 80-year-old, 46" & 36" dbh Western Red Cedars at 5th Ave NE & 178th.

Shoreline is going downhill in so many ways. Surely protecting our trees would be a wonderful and attainable legacy for you to leave our community.
