I have read the Staff Report 032822-8a page 15 that was prepared for the Counil's action on Ordinance No. 963 - Amending SMC 20.50.300, Adding a New Section Regarding Penalties for the Unpermitted Removal of Trees and Vegetation.

I feel this code could be made much easier to read and less likely to lead to accidental tree removals if it used the numerical size of trees instead of the words "significant" and "landmark." Below you can see both staff revisions with my suggested clarifications followed by what the language would like if both were made. I hope you will consider them.

My suggestions are in brown italics.

SMC 20.50.300 (H)

- 5. Penalties. Any *responsible* party violating any of the provisions of this <u>Sub</u>chapter may be subject to any applicable penalties per SMC 20.30.770 plus the following:
 - a) A square footage cost of \$3.00 per square foot of impacted tree, root zone(s), and understory vegetation required for retention that are impacted at the development site; and a square footage cost of \$15.00 per square foot of impacted vegetation and trees at the development site in the MUR-35' and MUR-45' zones; and
