- Q 1. Do we know how many wastewater bills are currently being sent to a different address, either because a duplicate bill is sent to the residential address, multiple bills are sent to one location, or bills sent to an address outside of Shoreline?
- Q 2. Do we know how many properties receive a residential wastewater bill versus other categories

**Answer:** Following is the count of duplicate bills and total accounts by residential or commercial. Note that Residential includes Multifamily up to 4 units. Commercial is all other, including larger multi-family.

Q 3. Do we have a sense of to what degree apartment/condo owners in a multi-family structures generally include wastewater as part of the rent or whether separate bills are sent to each unit.

**Answer**: Apartments over 4 units always receive a consolidated bill. They are never sent to individual units.
