- Case rates in King County moved back up to the medium risk level today.
- Shoreline is averaging 22 cases per day, an increase of 29% compared with the previous 7 days.
- While masks are not required, they are strongly recommended in indoor settings.
- Get vaccinated and a booster if you are eligible.
- Improve indoor air quality through ventilation.
- Get tested and stay home if you have symptoms.
