## Wear a mask and get vaccinated

- Case rates in King County are at the medium risk level.
- However, case rates in Shoreline are slightly down. We are averaging 20 cases per day. This is a 13% decrease compared to the prior 7 day period.
- While masks are not required, they are strongly recommended in indoor settings.
- Get vaccinated and a booster if you are eligible.
- Improve indoor air quality through ventilation.
- Get tested and stay home if you have symptoms.
