Dear Councilmembers,

I support the City buying this beach parcel. The property is assessed at \$107,000, which is a small expense that would preserve beach access forever.

The Proposition 1 Parks Bond passed recently. The \$38,000,000 from taxpayers can be used not only to improve eight parks and facilities, but also for "acquiring and improving other park and recreational facilities in the City park system."

The City should acquire the beach parcel and use the bond funds if appropriate. As a longtime homeowner in Richmond Beach (26 years) the added parcel will enhance Saltwater Park for everyone.
