Regarding study item 9(b): staffing request. It is understandable more developments lead to more permit activity. More developments also lead to increased questions from citizens and more public record requests. As residents who live here, we pay property taxes, license fees, and city sales tax, and therefore residents with questions should also receive an appropriate level of response.

Question about a statement in [study item 9\(b\), page 1, paragraph 1](#): "This trend is expected to continue over the next several years, with current projects of 7,947 units to develop by 2025." This refers to "current projects" - is it possible to get a location list of these projects?

Richmond Beach - we continue to have questions about the **20th Avenue NW new sidewalk**. The design is now 8' wide along 20th Ave NW from 190th to 193rd, and 10' wide from 193rd to 195th. We ask for a continuous 8 foot wide sidewalk. We are completing the survey but we have concerns that the design will be at 100% before we get answers. Can the City set up a FAQ sheet to answer the questions as emailed to the project manager and Council on 5/16/22? Thank you.
