

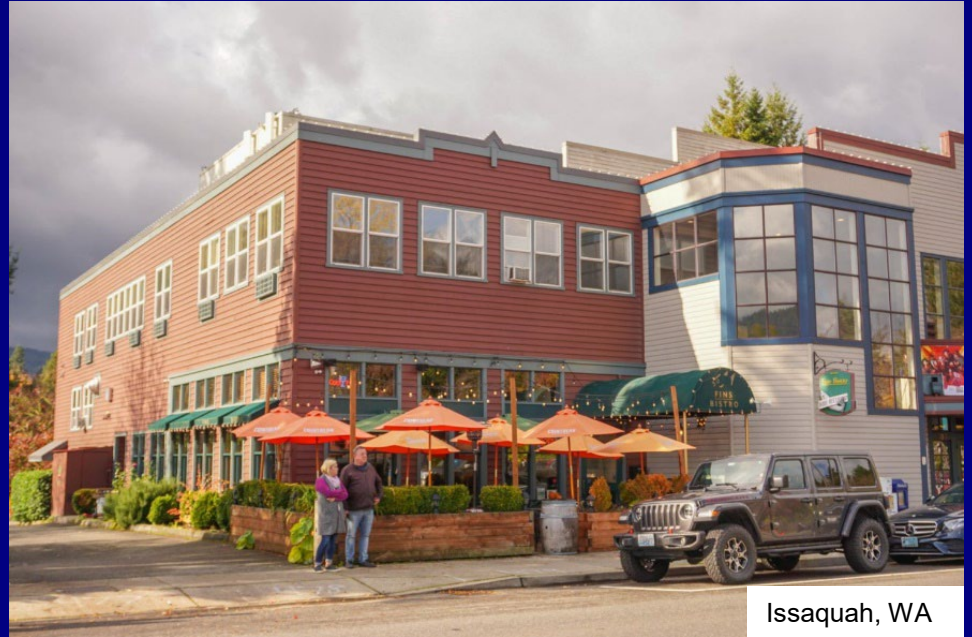

Draft Code – Overview

- Simple, flexible regulations
- The area must comply with other applicable regulations
- Allowed with associated eating/drinking use
- Allows conversion of off-street parking
- Design standards for furniture elements

Draft Code – Off-Street Parking

- Outdoor seating areas not required to provide additional off-street parking
- Allows conversion of some off-street parking to seating area:
 - Single-tenant site: Up to 4 parking spaces, or 30%, whichever is greater
 - Multi-tenant site: Up to 4 parking spaces per tenant, or 30%, whichever is lesser
