**Dear Shoreline City Council,**

**I am writing to you because I am concerned about the loss of so many of our significant mature trees as we continue to develop around the light rail stations.**

**YES, I support tree retention on MUR-70' zones:** 10% on 70' building sites; 15% on 80' building sites; 20% on 90' and 140' building sites.

Deep Green and other incentive programs will not eliminate tree retention.

**YES, I support that this code becomes effective upon Council approval (within 2 weeks). Shoreline is losing too many significant trees now.**

**NO, I do not support the Staff Amendatory Motion #8** on page 8a-22 of the 9/12/22 Council agenda.

**NO, I do not support giving the Director discretion** to reduce and waive tree retention on MUR-70' zones.
