



Hang Time Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

How is Hang Time changing this year?

- Hang Time is not a drop-in program. Students will need to register to attend Hang Time.
- Registration will be monthly to accommodate schedules and provide the best programming possible.

How will registration work?

- Students must be registered to attend Hang Time. Register online at [Activity search | Online Services \(activecommunities.com\)](https://www.activecommunities.com)
- Students can register the 21st of each month for the following month.
- As an example: If a student is registered for October, they can attend all Hang Time days in October. They will need to register for November to attend Hang Time in November.

What happens if a student comes to Hang Time who is not registered?

- Students cannot attend Hang Time if they are not registered.
- Staff will contact the school and the families to ensure the student gets home safely.

Who are the staffing team? Do they work for the school?

- We are employees for the Youth and Teen Development program of the City of Shoreline. We work in partnership with Kellogg/Einstein Middle School and the Shoreline School District.

What days of the week does Hang Time run?

- Tuesday, Wednesday (early release included), Thursday

What if my student wants to participate in a school sponsored club?

- The schools will provide a school club list.
- Students can sign up and attend school sponsored clubs through the registration process.

What are the hours?

- Tuesday & Thursday
 - 3:10-4:50
- Wednesday
 - 1:30-4:50

How will my child get home?

- Students can ride the bus, walk or coordinate a ride home.
- The schools will provide activity buses home after Hang Time.
 - Activity buses have different bus routes.



- Please ensure that your student knows what bus they need to get on after the program.
- It is helpful if your student knows their address and your phone number so we can help them figure out which bus to take if they do not remember.

What happens if we don't get a spot in Hang Time?

- If you don't get a spot, you will be placed in the waitlist. We will contact you if a spot becomes available.

What if students sign-up and don't come to the program?

- With limited spots available, we want students to participate if they are registered. If a student doesn't come for 3 consecutive days or 5 total days staff will call families to see if that student will be attending, if not, that student will be removed from Hang Time to allow for someone else to join.

What if my student is participating in a sport? Can they come for early release?

- Students must be registered for Hang Time to attend. If your child is participating in a sport, they should not register for Hang Time.

Can my child eat food from home while at Hang Time?

- Yes, food from home is ok. We do ask that participants do not order food delivery.

Can I pick my child up early?

- It is ok, but we prefer the participants stay for the whole duration.

Does my child need to be signed out by an adult?

- No, your child may sign themselves out at any time. Please note, if they sign themselves out early, they are not permitted back on school grounds for the rest of the day (unless they are returning for a school approved event).

What does Hang Time cost?

- Hang Time is free!

Can participants switch around clubs?

- No, once a participant has chosen their club they must stay with that club for the duration of the day. Participants may choose different clubs on a day-to-day basis.

What happens if the school is cancelled/closed?

- Hang Time will be closed.



What happens if there is an emergency or inclement weather?

- If an incident occurs after school hours and Hang Time needs to be cancelled, families will be called, and transportation will be coordinated for students to get home.

What are Hang Time participants supposed to do on Mondays and Fridays since there is no Hang Time?

- Hang Time is a free afterschool program provided by the City of Shoreline on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Hang Time offers structured clubs to help enrich our participants in a fun and safe environment. For a more daily option, we do have the Richmond Highlands Teen Center which is open till 6pm Monday-Thursday and extended hours on Fridays.
