



**UTILITY DISCOUNT PROGRAM (UDP)**

Eligible customers save 60% off their SCL and 50% off their SPU costs (206) 684-0268

- Household income does not exceed 70% of state median income
- Applicant must be the primary account holder listed on the SCL account

- Household income does not exceed 150% Federal Poverty Level
- SCL Pledge up to \$1000 (electric, gas, wood, propane, or oil)**
- SPU Pledge up to \$2500 (water & sewer only)**

**SEATTLE CITY LIGHT EMERGENCY BILL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (EBAP) (Formerly ELIA)**

A program that helps active customers with past due balances greater than \$250 or those who have received a 10-Day Disconnection Notice (206) 684-3688

- Household income does not exceed 80% of state median income
- Applicant must be the primary account holder listed on the SCL account
- Maximum pledge is \$500 for the current year
- For 2022 only, two EBAP pledges are available (maximum total pledge of \$1000) for all eligible households
- EBAP will refer customer to Project Share Program if eligible for further assistance

**SEATTLE CITY LIGHT PROJECT SHARE (PS)**

A donations-based program that helps toward SCL bill when funding is available (206) 684-3000 (Referrals come from Call Center or another assistance program)

- Household income does not exceed 80% of state median income
- Assists SCL customers with paying their SCL bill with amounts due between a minimum of \$125 and does not exceed \$1,000 (during the date of referral)
- Project Share is available once every 12 months with a maximum of \$250 toward applicant's SCL bill (Up to \$500, only if customer matches dollar for dollar above \$250)
- Applicant must be the primary account holder listed on the SCL account

**SEATTLE PUBLIC UTILITIES EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (SPU-EAP)**

A Seattle Public Utilities program that helps towards your utility bill (206) 684-5800

- Household income does not exceed 80% state median income
- Must be a Single-Family Residence (Duplex and larger does not qualify)
- SPU Emergency Assistance Program max pledge is \$477 for current year
- For 2022 only, two SPU-EAP pledges are available (maximum total pledge of \$954) for all eligible households
