Oral testimony to 10/6/22 Planning Commission Meeting re Agenda Item 6a, 2022 Comprehensive Plan Amendments.

My name is Susanne Tsoming, Shoreline resident

My comment is about the statement appearing under Agenda Item 6a in tonight's Staff Report for 2022 Comprehensive Plan Amendments. It concerns Amendment #3, the Shoreline P&R property located at 19000 Aurora Ave N.¹ I disagree with the assumption that Shoreline P&R property "becomes less utilized, once light rail service commences." I believe the opposite will happen. With the expected increase in the City's population, a car or two per household², there will be a need for more, instead of fewer, parking spaces at the Shoreline P&R. Shoreline is scheduled in 2024 for the opening of two Sound Transit Light Rail stations, 185<sup>th</sup> known as Shoreline North and 148<sup>th</sup> known as Shoreline South. There will be approximately 1,000 parking stalls available (500 at each Light Rail station). Unless you live within walking distance to the Light Rail stations, you will have to drive or bus to them. The draft transit plan in the 2022 Shoreline Transportation Master Plan Update recognizes that frequent, express and local bus service must be utilized to meet the connection need. Therefore, I support Option A, the standalone transit garage with 401 dedicated transit stalls as shown in tonight's Agenda as Att. F of the KC Metro TOD Study.
