





## Operating Budget Expenditures by Function








#### **Surface Water Utility**

# **Proposed Amendments**



## City Manager Recommended LLL Amendments

- 1. Increase General Fund appropriations by \$791,289 and increase FTE count by 2.9 to address critical operational needs by adding the following:
- Information Technology Specialist (1.0 FTE)
- Conversion of Video/Web Specialist from extra-help to regular position (0.5 FTE)
- Human Resources Specialist (1.0 FTE)
- Recreation Specialist from 0.6 FTE to 1.0 FTE

# City Council Proposed One Time Amendments

- 2. Update to City's Urban Tree Canopy Assessment -\$50k (CM Mork, Pobee, & Roberts)
- 3. Completion of the City's Street inventory \$200k (CM Mork & Pobee)
- 4. Increase funding for small roads safety projects -\$362k (CM Mork)

## City Council Proposed Sidewalk Amendments

- 5. 200<sup>th</sup> St NE from 30<sup>th</sup> NE to 25<sup>th</sup> Ave NE Sidewalk -\$1.85M (CM Roberts)
- 6. Wallingford from N 195<sup>th</sup> to N 192<sup>nd</sup> Sidewalk \$.99M (CM Roberts)
- 7. Wallingford from N 155th to N 150<sup>th</sup> -\$.96M (CM Roberts)
  - Each sidewalk project would need a partial 3-year limited term engineer to complete.

## City Council Proposed Ongoing Amendments

- 8. 0.50 FTE to support social media and digital communications -\$75k (CM Roberts)
- 9. Install Synthetic turf field at Shoreview Park \$700k (CM Roberts)
- Addition ongoing support to supplement contracted direct mental health support -\$75k (CM Roberts)
