Interlocal for Homelessness Services

- Proposed Interlocal Agreement with Shoreline, Lake Forest Park, Kenmore, Bothell, Woodinville and the KCRHA
- Presented to Council on August 15, 2022, for discussion
- Staff worked with KCRHA and participating cities to update interlocal to reflect feedback from cities



Impact of Interlocal

- Consolidate funding for homelessness programs to KCHRA
- Phased approach
 - 2023-2024 – Shoreline will transfer the previously approved funding to programs to KCRHA to implement (approximately \$100,000)
 - 2025-2025 – Shoreline will provide funding (minimum of \$1.20/per capita); KCRHA would determine specific programming in the North KC subregion, in alignment with KC Sub-Regional Plan

Council Concerns	Location in Proposed Agreement
Clarify that KCRHA will allocate all funds provided with no overhead taken	Exhibit A, Bullet Number 3
Provide specific language that the funding from the sub-region will stay within the sub-region	Exhibit A, Bullet Number 4, Allowable expenses
List a specific per capita share minimum for cities	Exhibit B, \$1.20/per capita (WA OFM); cities retain option to allocate more
Contain language that allows cities to enter into separate agreements for homeless services	Exhibit B, bolded paragraph
