- 8. Hello. I am a property owner on the block of 14509 3rd Ave NE, the subject property of Resolution 948. I watched the Council recording from November 21 where the issue of whether to designate the remainder of the lot as surplus. One of the ideas given was to keep the remainder as a park/green space, and I am writing to provide input on this. In short, I do not think using this small lot is best used as a park/green space because it's too close to the freeway and will be difficult to access.

Having lived on 3rd Ave NE, I recommend the City use one or several of its lots further west for green space. Green space is obviously really important, but I speak from years of personal experience when I say the traffic on this particular corner, situated on I5 and 145th, is so loud that it can be difficult to have a conversation with someone next to you. It's also quite smelly with all the car exhaust. And lastly, it's the least accessible corner on the entire block, and with the pedestrian bridge going up near 147th, and foot traffic being directed that direction I can't imagine who would even use it.

If the City wants green space for the benefit of its residents, it should pick a location where people

might actually want to enjoy it. From a financial perspective, \$1.66M is a lot of money that could be better used making a more pleasant and usable green space just west of this block.
