Role of legislative priorities

- Clear direction to City representatives
- Consistent information about City priorities
- Policy guidance in dynamic legislative environment
- Allows City to embrace opportunity



- Shoreline-specific needs
 – federal funding short term:
 - RAISE Grant for 145th Corridor/148th Bridge
 - Ballinger Creek partnership with Lake Forest Park/Water Resources Development Act
 - Implementing 2022 funding from Rep. Jayapal



- Shoreline-specific needs
 – federal funding long term:
 - Infrastructure/climate opportunities
 - Trail Along the Rail
 - 175th Corridor
 - 185th Station Area



- Looking ahead: Next Transportation Authorization Bill (est. 2026 timeframe)
 - Monitor current activities; identify areas of improvement
 - Medium-sized city set-aside
 - Non-motorized and transit emphasis



- Ongoing advocacy for:
 - Climate change measures
 - Increased access to health insurance
 - Childcare and support for families
 - Tax code changes
 - Salmon recovery and watershed restoration



Ongoing advocacy for:

 Additional infrastructure investments
 Increased formula funding for cities
 Policies that support a safe, healthy, inviting and equitable community for all
