

- 1st Ave NE @ NE 157th St to NE 159th St (May)
- NE 195th St @ I-5 to 10th Ave NE (June)
- NE 161st @ I-5 to 2nd Ave.NE (June)
- Ridgecrest Park Restoration (July)
- 3rd Ave NE @ NE 151st St to end north of NE 152nd St (July)
- 5th Ave NE @ NE 182nd Ct to NE 185th St (July)
- 5th Ave NE @ NE 145th St to NE 148th St (August)

Potable Water Discharges to City Right-of-Way Discharges to the City's stormwater system from potable water sources, including but not limited to water line flushing, hyper chlorinated water line flushing, fire hydrant system flushing, and pipeline hydrostatic test water, are conditionally allowed under the City's municipal stormwater permit. Planned discharges shall meeting the following requirements:

- Dechlorinated to a total residual chlorine concentration of 0.1 ppm or less,
- · pH-adjusted (if necessary), and
- Volumetrically and velocity controlled to prevent re-suspension of sediments

Staging of Materials in Stormwater Ditches

The City's Municipal Stormwater
Permit prohibits uncontrolled
materials from being placed in our
drainage system. This practice could
lead to water quality, storage
capacity, and runoff conveyance
problems.

Utility Cross Bore Removals

The City continues to work with utility companies to remove cross bores and repair damaged storm pipes and drains. Please report any known damage to storm pipes during cross boring or other trenchless methods.

As the Surface Water Utility video inspects previously uninspected pipes, it is expected that additional cross bores will be discovered throughout the City.

Surface Water Drainage Patterns




Pavement Maintenance/Moratorium Map




Seattle City Light expects to perform routine maintenance line clearance tree trimming within the City of Shoreline in the year of 2023.






