Incomplete submittals and documents not meeting the standards listed below will not be accepted for review.

Submittal Standards

Applications for this type of permit must be submitted electronically. Please review the City's <u>Electronic</u> <u>Permitting handout</u> to find out how to set up an account, submit applications, submit revisions, check on your permit status and more.

All forms and plans must be in Portable Document Format (PDF). PDFs shall be printed or plotted to PDF, not scans of an image. All PDF plans shall be plotted to scale and include a graphic scale bar. PDFs shall be flattened and unlocked to allow for document mark-up. A 2-inch tall by 3-inch-wide space must be left blank on the cover sheet of all plans to allow for City stamps.

Drawings must be clear, and information must be legible. Documents must be named in accordance with the <u>City's naming conventions</u>. Each document listed below must be uploaded as its own PDF file and may not be combined with other documents.

Required Documents

- ☑ Wastewater Permit Application
- ✓ Industrial Discharge Application and Permit
- ☑ Submittal Fee
 - Please reference the City's <u>fee schedule</u> for current application fees.
- ☑ Civil Engineering Plans
 - o Refer to the Civil Engineering Plans Handout for plan sheet requirements.
 - Must show utility locations of all existing and proposed utilities including water, sewer, gas, electric, and telecommunications.
 - Location of existing streets, easements, and driveways. Include driveways on adjacent property and adjacent streets.

- A profile view of the proposed wastewater line.
- Include all details which describe the project.
- Frontage improvements for curb, gutter, sidewalk, access drive, drainage facilities, and street trees that may require restoration.
- ☑ Traffic Control Plan
 - Standard WSDOT traffic control plans are acceptable.
- ☑ Proof of Side Sewer Contractor License, Bonding, and/or Insurance.
 - For any work in the public Right-of-Way, public liability insurance is required. All contractors, not working for a franchised utility company and/or individual, must provide a certificate of liability insurance naming the City of Shoreline and Shoreline Wastewater as additional insured. (See separate <u>Side Sewer Contractor Licensing Packet</u>).

Additional Documents (Possibly Required)

- □ Authorization Letter
 - Required for all projects except for de-chlorination of approved water utilities.
 - Letter must be from King County or the Edmonds Wastewater Treatment Plant.

 - Required for sewer work in the right-of-way.
