## HOW IT WORKS

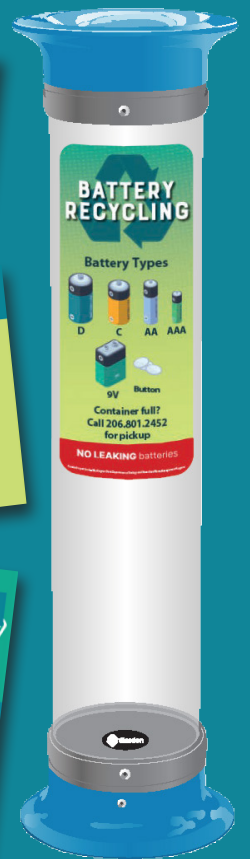
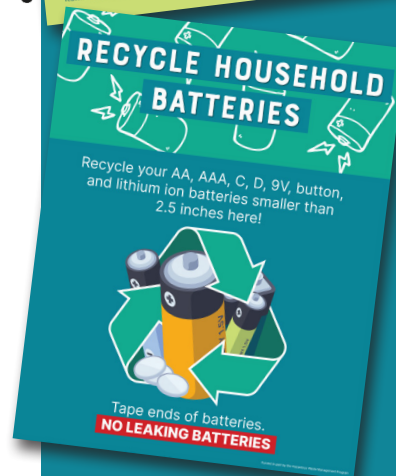
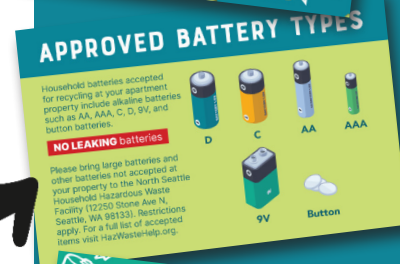
- We help determine if your property has a suitable location for a battery recycling station

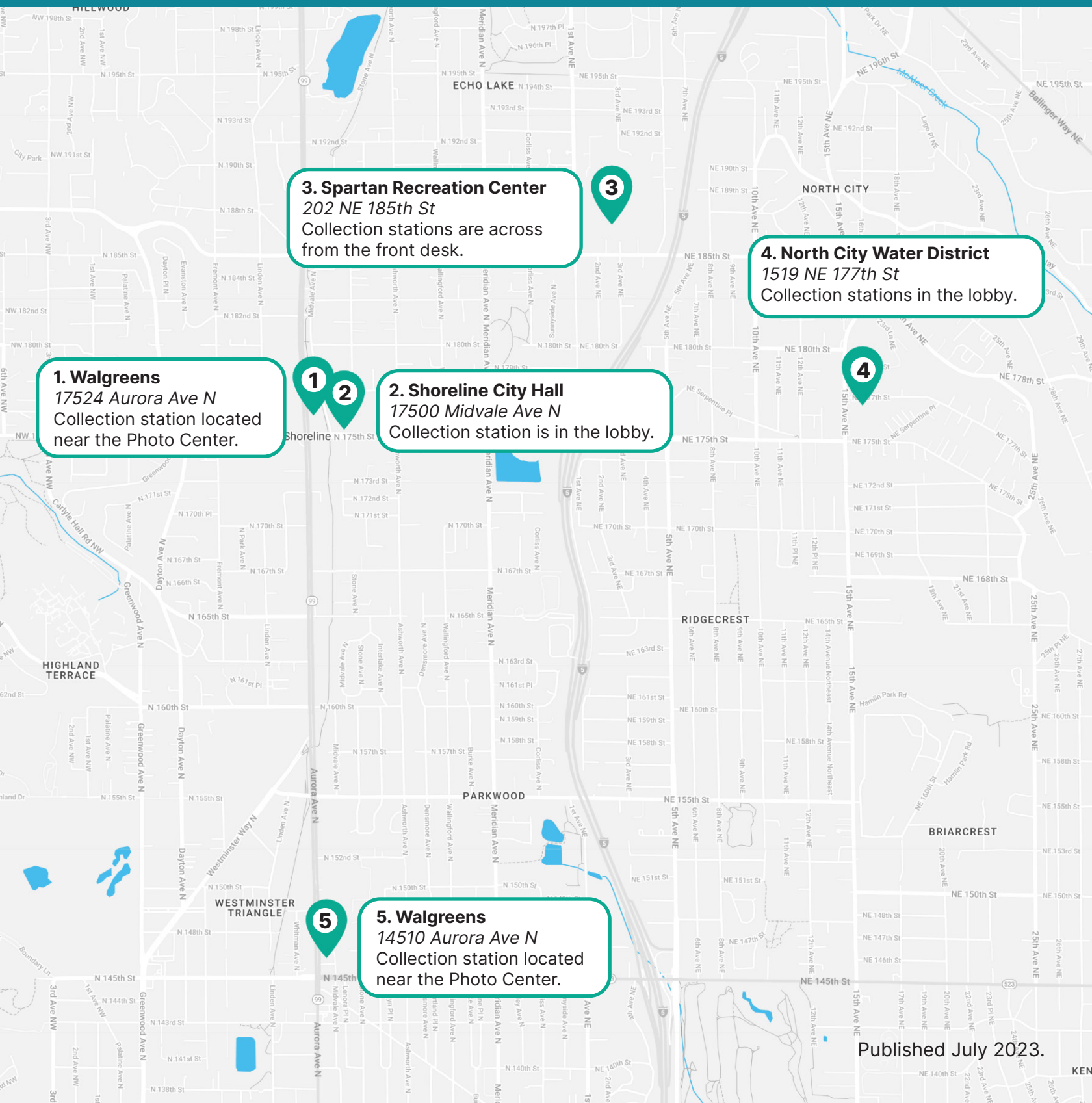
