## BENEFITS

- Greater access and convenience to specialty recycling for your tenants
- Less contamination in your curbside recycle containers
- More plastic gets recycled instead of filling up landfills

## WHAT WE PROVIDE

- Collection station materials and signage
- Educational materials for tenants
- Assistance with troubleshooting as needed

## HOW IT WORKS

- We provide you with the supplies and materials to set up a plastic bag and wrap collection station at your property
- We help you decide where to set up the station and where to take the clean recyclables once it is full
- You commit to taking the clean recyclables to a free drop-off location near you, typically once per week for 100+ unit properties
- We help you troubleshoot as needed
- Your tenants conveniently recycle items that are not accepted curbside

# DROP-OFF LOCATIONS

Recycle your plastics bags and film at a location nearest you!



**3. Safeway**  
23632 Hwy 99 (Edmonds)  
Drop-off bins inside store at Guest Services and at east entrance near shopping carts.



**1. QFC**  
600 NW Richmond Beach Rd  
Drop-off bin is inside store in the back NE corner next to the wine and produce depts.



**2. Fred Meyer**  
18325 Aurora Ave N  
Drop-off bins inside both entrance lobbies.



**4. Safeway**  
17202 15th Ave NE  
Drop-off bin outside of store near main entrance doors.



**5. Shoreline Transfer Station**  
2300 N 165th St  
Ask attendant for clean plastic bag recycle location.

**6. Safeway**  
15332 Aurora Ave N  
Drop-off bin is next to the Starbucks inside the store.
