The City of Shoreline requires food service businesses to use compostable or reusable service ware, SMC Chapter 14.15. Recognizing that complying with this requirement may be difficult for some businesses, the City is providing a waiver program. This form can be used by businesses that wish to apply for a waiver from these service ware requirements.

### **EXEMPT PLASTIC FOOD SERVICE PRODUCTS**

The following plastic food service products are exempt until **June 1, 2025,** and <u>do not</u> need a waiver:

- Catering trays
- Clear food wrap and shrink wrap
- Containers for uniquely shaped foods like cupcakes and deviled eggs
- Flexible plastic packaging used to preserve moisture and freshness such as for cookies
- Containers or trays for hot meat items like ribs and rotisserie chicken
- Small absorbent pads put under meat or seafood to absorb liquids in the package
- Metal foil and metal foil-faced papers used to wrap hot food such as fried chicken, hamburgers, and burritos
- Disposable metal loaf pans used to bake food items that are then sold to customers in the same container

### **WAIVER REQUIREMENTS**

Waiver from the requirement to use reusable service ware for on-site dining

If you would like to **use commercially approved compostable service ware instead of reusable items**, you must show you are not able to comply with this requirement due to:

- Insurmountable space constraints for a dishwashing system;
- Undue financial hardship; and/or
- Other extraordinary circumstances.

Waiver from the requirement to use compostable service ware for off-site dining

If you would like to **use disposable plastic service ware instead of compostable items**, you must show:

- There are not at least two suitable compostable alternatives for the plastic item; and/or
- There are not at least two companies that make a suitable compostable alternative for the plastic item.
