Dear Shoreline Resident,

The construction of the Meridian Avenue N Safety Improvements project will begin this summer. Public Outreach and Community Engagement was done in 2022 with planned construction in 2023. Due to project planning conflicts, construction was postponed to 2024. The project will provide pedestrian and transportation safety improvements along Meridian Avenue N for all modes of transportation.

Safety improvements include:

- Restriping to add a bike lane in each direction of Meridian Avenue N and include center turn lanes. As a reminder, street parking will be removed in some sections of Meridian Ave N and will be reduced to one side of the street in others to add bike lanes. Refer to attached exhibit.
- Adding a pedestrian refuge island at the pedestrian activated rectangular rapid flashing beacon (RRFB) at N 170th Street.
- Installing a new RRFB at the N 163rd Street.

You will receive a construction notification postcard in the mail before construction begins.

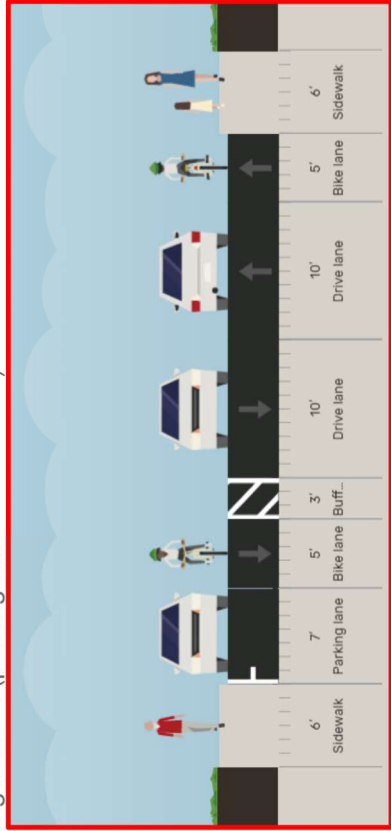
