2023 Accomplishments

2023 Accomplishments

- 5,600+ permit applications
- 4,270 inspections building construction customers
- 3,275 right-of-way permit inspections
- 561 sewer inspections

2023 Accomplishments

- Adopted new Cottage Housing regulations
- New requirements for ground floor commercial space in multi-family buildings

2023 Accomplishments

- Connected 240 small business owners with resources
- Issued 2 mixed use building permits under Deep Green Incentive program for a total of 790 LEED Platinum units
- Awarded \$38 million in grant funding for capital projects, with over \$36 million for the 145th Corridor Project.
- Collected:
 - \$2.8 million in Transportation Impact Fees
 - \$4.2 million in Park Impact Fees

2023 Accomplishments

- 760 pothole repairs
- Cleaned 53 miles of wastewater main pipe and inspected another 17 miles
- Removed 1,189 graffiti tags

2023 Accomplishments

- Processed 740 public disclosure requests

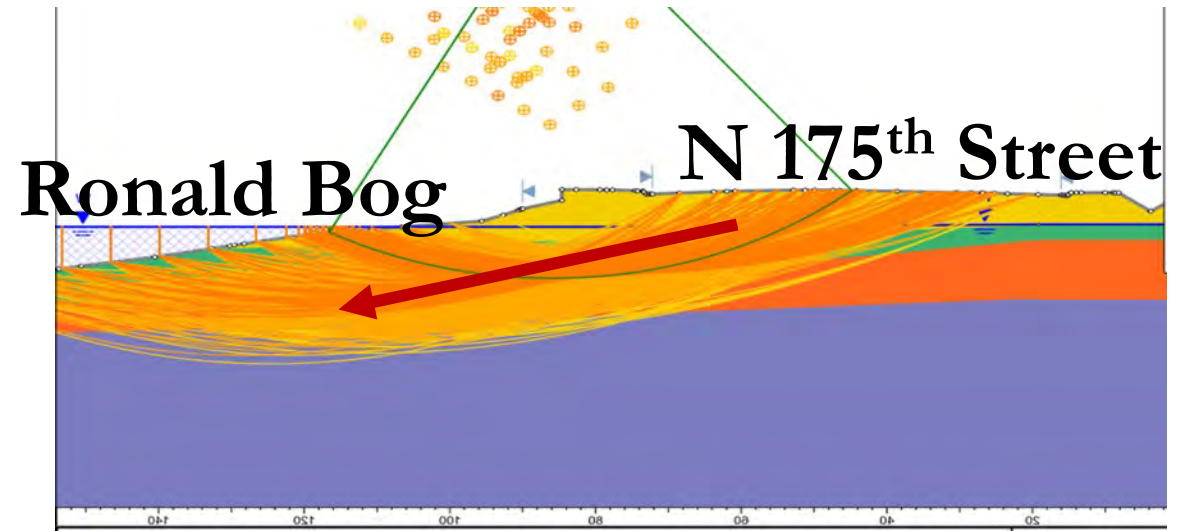

- We work closely with arborist to protect and preserve trees
- We can't achieve climate goals without improving sidewalks and streets for a more accessible community
- Largest contributor to GHG emissions is transportation – 55%

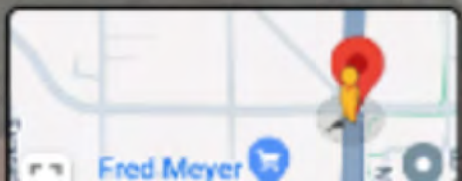
