Shoreline Scooter & Bike Share Pilot Program

The City of Shoreline is excited to announce a two-year pilot program for scooter and bike share, supporting our commitment to sustainable transportation as outlined in the City's Transportation Element and Climate Action Plan.

The program will run until August 2026 and start with 200 devices, including 50 bikes, operated by Lime (maximum number of devices is capped at 400).

Safety First!

- Riders must be 18 years of age or older.
- Lime offers an in-app guide on safe scooting practices.
- · Helmets are required by Lime and strongly encouraged by the City.
- There is a 10% discount for wearing a helmet on your ride verified through the Lime app.

Find and Rent a Scooter

- Download the Lime app (https://www.li.me/) for iPhone or Android.
- Locate an available scooter through the app or find one parked around the City.
- Scan the 6-digit QR code on the handlebar with your phone's camera or enter it manually.
- Start your ride!

Pricing + Payment:

- Lime app will charge \$1 to unlock and \$0.45 per minute (subject to change during the pilot)
- Lime offers monthly subscriptions and bundles for a discounted rate visit Lime (https://www.li.me/) and download the app for more information.
- Discounted rate (subject to change): \$0.75 to unlock and \$0.01 per minute for Lime Access users that qualify (Users of SNAP, WIC, Medicaid, Subsidized Housing). You can also sign up without needing a smartphone. Signup Here: https://www.li.me/why/community/lime-access.

Speed Limits:

Scooters: 15 mphBikes: 20 mph

Where to Ride:

- Service area map is in the Lime App (https://www.li.me/) Includes rides to and from Seattle.
- No riding on roads 35 mph or above in Shoreline.
- No riding inside parks.
- No riding in designated zones like public facilities, parks, overpasses, school yards.

Where to Park:

- Bike racks.
- Curb/landscape strip next to sidewalks (out of the pedestrian path and upright).
- Preferred scooter/bikeshare parking zones (marked by "P" in Lime App).

Do not park or block:

- Sidewalks or pedestrian access and public seating areas.
- ADA access ramps and other facilities.
- Traffic lanes, Fire lanes, bus lanes, bike lanes, or trails.
- Stay away from fire hydrants and building fire access points and bus shelters or waiting areas.
- On private property without permission.
