The City of Shoreline Notice of Public Hearing and Public Meeting

The City of Shoreline is conducting a public hearing for the periodic update to its Comprehensive Plan ("Plan") to cover the 20-year period from 2024 through 2044, which per RCW 36.70A.130(5)(a) must be completed by December 31, 2024 and the Draft Environmental Impact Statement which has been developed to understand potential impacts and needed mitigation measures to address various levels of growth that may occur over the next twenty years through 2044. The Plan is the city's primary policy document for guiding growth and development over the next 20 years and covers a wide range of topics such as environment, land use, housing, transportation, parks and recreation, economic development, utilities, and capital facilities. The Plan must be consistent with the Growth Management Act, Puget Sound Regional Council Vision 2050 Plan, and King County Countywide Planning Policies (CPPs).

Threshold Determination: The City of Shoreline determined that the proposal to adopt the 2024 Comprehensive Plan may potentially have a significant adverse impact on the environment and issued a Determination of Significance on November 1, 2023.

Public Hearing: The Planning Commission of the City of Shoreline will hold a Public Hearing during a special meeting of the Planning Commission on October 24, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. The public hearing will be held in person and virtually using an online application.

This meeting is being conducted in a hybrid format and you may attend the meeting in person (Council Chambers at City Hall, 17500 Midvale Avenue N, Shoreline, WA) or join via Zoom webinar or over the telephone. Public testimony is being accepted in person, remotely, or by submitting written comment. Written comments should be submitted to Steven Szafran, AICP, Senior Planner, at sszafran@shorelinewa.gov by no later than 4:00 p.m. local time on the date of the hearing. The Planning Commission's special meeting and public hearing will follow at 7:00 pm.
