The City expects to issue a SEPA Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) on this project. The optional DNS process in WAC 197-11-355 is being used. This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of this proposal. The proposal may include mitigation measures under applicable codes, and the project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an environmental impact statement is prepared. A copy of the subsequent threshold determination for the specific proposal may be obtained upon request.

**Project Details** The City of Shoreline Public Works Department intends to make improvements to wastewater Lift Station 12, including the replacement of pumps in the existing dry pit, installation of a new flowmeter, and miscellaneous improvements inside the existing lift station building. The project includes installing a stormwater pipe and associated manholes within the Richmond Beach Dr NW and NW 195th Pl intersection. Work will be within public rights-of-way, portions of Richmond Beach Dr NW and NW 195th Pl.

The applicant has just made their application, no decisions have been made at this time. This is your opportunity to provide comments. You will receive another notice, later in the process, when a decision has been made.

## Q: How can I provide effective comments?

A: Effective comments are detailed and generally relate to the decision criteria for this permit or project type. For example, instead of a statement saying: "I hate this project!" or "I love this project!" it might be more effective to say, "I am concerned about the impacts this project will have on tree canopy coverage," or "I support this project because our City needs more housing."
