

# IS YOUR YARD READY FOR WINTER STORM SEASON?

There are steps that should be taken **Before, During, and After** a storm.

Please save this information so that you can be prepared.

## Pre-Storm Maintenance

- **Cut back trees and weak branches that contact structures**
- **Thin foliage so wind can flow freely through branches**
- **Remove and/or store inside any loose yard items, such as toys, lawn furniture, etc.**
- **Clean storm drains of any debris that may block the flow of water**

## Post-Storm Clean Up

- **Keep household garbage, recycling and storm debris (tree limbs, etc.) separate**
- **Place household garbage at the curb on your regular collection day**
- **Please be patient! Household garbage collection is a top priority**

## Storm Debris

- **Wait for instructions on the disposing of storm debris (from the City of Shoreline and Cleanscapes)**
- **Never place debris near or on a fence, mail box, hydrant, power pole, transformer, storm drain, etc.**
- **Hidden hazards can injure or kill collection personnel**
