

## EARTHQUAKE CLEAN UP

Cleaning up your home after an earthquake can be a challenge. The following information will help get you started. Please save this information so that you can be prepared.

- **Keep household garbage, recycling, building debris and vegetative debris separate. This is extremely important!**
- **Securely containerize all household garbage in plastic bags or cans and place at the curb on your scheduled collection day.**
- **Please be patient! Collection of household garbage will be a top priority and will resume once dangerous conditions subside. DO NOT mix your household garbage with other disaster debris!**
- **Refrigerators must be emptied and doors removed, or secured with duct tape.**
