## ORDINANCE NO. 8

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON, TO APPOINT THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE AS AUDITING OFFICER.

WHEREAS, the Revised Code of Washington requires that the legislative authority of political entities appoint an auditing officer; and

WHEREAS, the auditing officer must preaudit all claims against a municipality and certify to their authenticity; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager or his or her designee audits all expenditures of the City; and NOW, THEREFORE,

## THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** Appointment. The City Council hereby appoints the City Manager or his or her designee as auditing officer.
- **Section 2.** <u>Severability</u>. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Effective Date. This ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force (5) days after the date of publication.
