ORDINANCE NO. 26

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING AN UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE BENEFIT ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 50.44.030 and 50.44.060, the City has the authority to make payments into a City unemployment insurance benefit account in lieu of making contributions to State unemployment insurance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it to be in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to establish such an account; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. <u>Unemployment Insurance Benefit Account Created Purpose Deposits.</u> There is created a new account entitled Unemployment Insurance Benefit Account which shall be utilized for the reimbursement of unemployment benefits paid by the Employment Security Department of the State and chargeable to the City. Deposits shall be made to such account from City operating funds on a monthly basis or other intervals as determined by the City Council.
 - A. <u>Expenditures.</u> Expenditures from such account shall be made from time to time as required by law to reimburse the Employment Security Department of the State for unemployment benefits paid by it and chargeable to the City.
 - B. <u>Administration</u>. The City Manager or Designee is authorized and directed to establish and administer such account and to make such temporary investments of account proceeds in any manner authorized by law.
- Section 2. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this Ordinance be preempted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or preemption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date and Publication.</u> A summary of this ordinance consisting of its title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication or the date of incorporation as the law may require.
