RESOLUTION NO. 77

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO AUTHORITY TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE TELEVISION CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT OF 1992.

WHEREAS, the City of Shoreline had filed written certification with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), that will enable the City to exercise basic Rate Regulation Authority under the provisions of the Cable Television Consumer Protection Act of 1992 (47USCS§543) to ensure that cable providers operating in Shoreline comply with the requirements and limitations of that Act and NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City will adopt and administer Rate Regulation Rules in accord with the FCC Rules and Regulations.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City of Shoreline has the legal authority to adopt, and the personnel to administer, such Rules and Regulations; and the City of Shoreline will ensure that all procedures in rate regulation proceedings will provide a reasonable opportunity for consideration of the views of interested parties.
