

**RESOLUTION NO. 125**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE  
INNIS ARDEN CLUB, INC. TO PROCEED WITH EXPENDITURE  
OF ITS OFFICE OF NEIGHBORHOODS MINI-GRANT FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the 1996 budget of the City of Shoreline allocated \$5,000 for neighborhood enhancement in each of Shoreline 12 neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant funding provided by the City will be matched by the participating neighborhood in a donation of cash, goods, or labor equal to the value of the City grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the Innis Arden Club, Inc. has submitted a grant application for this program, which has been reviewed by City staff; and

WHEREAS, the Innis Arden Club has joined together with Sunset Elementary School in the creation of a public art project of tiles designed around the theme of "Our Sunset Community"; and


WHEREAS, Resolution No. 54 requires City Council approval of expenditure of Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant funds;

THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:**


**Section 1. Authorization.** The City Council hereby approves the expenditure of \$3,000 of Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant funding for the Innis Arden Club, Inc. tile project.
