## RESOLUTION NO. 144

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE RIDGECREST NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION TO PROCEED WITH EXPENDITURE OF ITS OFFICE OF NEIGHBORHOODS MINI-GRANT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the 1997 budget of the City of Shoreline allocated \$5000 for neighborhood enhancement in each of Shoreline's 13 neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant funding provided by the City will be matched by the participating neighborhood in a donation of cash, goods, or labor equal to the value of the City grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the Ridgcrest Neighborhood Association has submitted a grant application, which has been reviewed by City staff; and

WHEREAS, the Ridgcrest Neighborhood Association wishes to enhance the visual image of the area, prevent graffiti and improve neighborhood identification through the creation of a mural on the west wall of the Century Building located at N.E. 165<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> N.E.; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 54 requires City Council approval of expenditure of Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant funds;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:**


**Section 1. Authorization.** The City Council hereby approves the expenditure of Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant funding for the Ridgcrest Neighborhood Association project to create and install a mural at N.E. 165<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> N.E.

**Section 2. Recording of Mini-Grant Application.** The Ridgcrest Neighborhood Association Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant application has been filed with the City Clerk and given Clerk's Receiving Number 543.
