

**RESOLUTION NO. 140**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON,  
AUTHORIZING THE RICHMOND BEACH COMMUNITY COUNCIL  
TO PROCEED WITH EXPENDITURE OF ITS OFFICE OF  
NEIGHBORHOODS MINI-GRANT FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the 1997 budget of the City of Shoreline allocated \$5,000 for neighborhood enhancement in each of Shoreline's 13 neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant funding provided by the City will be matched by the participating neighborhood in a donation of cash, goods, or labor equal to the value of the City grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the Richmond Beach Community Council has submitted a grant application, which has been reviewed by City staff from Office of Neighborhoods and the Parks & Recreation Department; and

WHEREAS, the Richmond Beach Community Council is planning five projects to beautify and improve Richmond Beach Community Park, including the construction of a gazebo in the park; installation of two barbecues near the gazebo; landscaping in the park; and, completion of the border along the north side of the park with fencing and plantings; and


WHEREAS, Resolution No. 54 requires City Council approval of expenditure of Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant funds;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:**


**Section 1. Authorization.** The City Council hereby approves the expenditure of Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant funding for the Richmond Beach Community Council.

**Section 2. Recording of Mini-Grant Application.** The Richmond Beach Community Council Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant application has been filed with the City Clerk and given Clerk's Receiving Number 485.
