

RESOLUTION NO. 139

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE,
WASHINGTON, TO ESTABLISH A POLICY REGARDING THE
HANDLING AND DISPOSITION OF YARD WASTE**

WHEREAS, the City of Shoreline received a grant from the Department of Ecology and King County Waste Reduction and Recycling to purchase a chipper for the purpose of establishing a program of handling and disposition of yard waste; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to reduce the volume of materials entering streams and landfills; and

WHEREAS, the City expects that the efforts made will decrease wastestream entering landfills and reduce the need for new sites; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Shoreline is committed to reducing the amount of yard waste that enters our streams and landfills by 180-200 tons over the next two years.

Section 2. The City of Shoreline will offer community-wide chipping events to allow residents to assist with this reduction.

Section 3. The City of Shoreline is committed to collecting all woody yard waste generated by park and road maintenance crews.


Section 4. All chipped materials will be used and not become landfill.
