

**RESOLUTION NO. 127**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE RIDGECREST NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION TO PROCEED WITH EXPENDITURE OF ITS OFFICE OF NEIGHBORHOODS MINI-GRANT FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the 1996 budget of the City of Shoreline allocated \$5,000 for neighborhood enhancement in each of Shoreline's 12 neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant funding provided by the City will be matched by the participating neighborhood in a donation of cash, goods, or labor equal to the value of the City grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the Ridgecrest Neighborhood Association has submitted a grant application for this program, which has reviewed by City staff; and

WHEREAS, the Ridgecrest Neighborhood Association has joined together with the Paramount Park Neighborhood Group in a restoration project of Pacific Tree frogs to wetlands in Paramount Park approved in Resolution No. 124; and

WHEREAS, the Ridgecrest Neighborhood Association wishes to promote neighborhood beautification with a tree planting project at various sites in the Ridgecrest neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the Ridgecrest Neighborhood Association wishes to foster community identity and encourage involvement by facilitating the efficient dissemination of information and materials to the residents of the Ridgecrest neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 54 requires City Council approval of expenditure of Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant funds;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Authorization.** The City Council hereby approves the expenditure of \$2,000 of Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant funding for the Ridgecrest Neighborhood Association projects of tree planting in the neighborhood and neighborhood communication.

**Section 2. Recording of Mini-Grant Application.** The Ridgecrest Neighborhood Association Office of Neighborhoods Mini-Grant application has been filed with the City Clerk and given Clerk's Receiving Number 307.
